





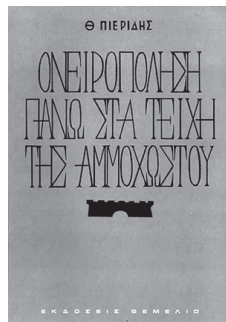
This is  Ghost Town  a condensed

*The typeface began as an offspring of an ongoing research project  
that attempts to collect, preserve, organize, study and share the  
visual story-path of the poetry-literature book covers in Cyprus  
➤ within the sphere of visual communication ↙*



Ghost Town's source of inspiration, is the lettering on the cover of a 1966 Cypriot book, titled *Ονειροπόληση Πάνω στα Τείχη της Αμμοχώστου* by poet Theodosios Pierides and was designed and illustrated by the Greek artist Dimos Skoulakis.



▣ The font takes its name from the description that was given to Varosha – an abandoned region within the city of Famagusta Cyprus, that stays uninhabited and off limits since the Turkish invasion in Cyprus in 1974. ¶ The project was funded by the Semiotics and Visual Communication Lab of the Cyprus University of Technology.

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
